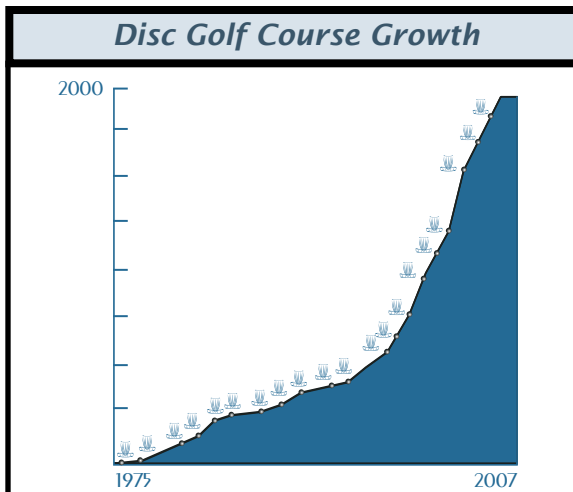

## What is Disc Golf?

Disc Golf is similar to regular golf, however, instead of using golf clubs and balls and aiming for a hole, Disc Golf players use golf discs and aim for a Disc Pole Hole™; a pole extending up from the ground with chains and a basket where the disc lands.

The object of the game is to complete each hole in the fewest number of throws, starting from a tee area and finishing at the Disc Pole Hole™. Generally, a course is 9 or 18 holes long. Players start at hole one and complete the course in order, playing through to the last hole. The player with the lowest total cumulative score, wins.

Disc Golf courses can use a wide variety of terrain. Often times, land not suitable for other park activities or development is perfect terrain for a Disc Golf course.

Disc Golf is one of the best lifetime fitness sports. It is easy to learn, a healthy activity, and accessible to people of all ages and fitness levels. If you can throw a Frisbee® and you like to have fun, you can play Disc Golf.
